General Business Meeting Minutes (Final Version)  
Held at the  
2012 Annual NAA Meeting, in Eureka, Nevada  
April 28, 2012**

**Meeting Called to Order:** 4pm

**President's Report:** President Eva Jensen introduced and thanked the current NAA Board for their work and assistance with the annual meeting. She announced that the NAA has produced a journal in the past few months, the first one in about two years. And we now are set up with a Pay Pal account through our website, allowing members and the public at large to purchase merchandise, journals, and register for the annual meeting. If others from the membership wanted to run for a place on the Board, they could request to be nominated. No one was nominated for Board positions, other than two persons, for the two vacancies. Krysan Williams and Nancy O'Connor were nominated and were voted in. There were no dissenting votes.
